

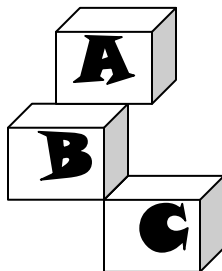

In 1983, he moved south to Brentwood and coached the Bruins for the next twenty years. After the 2003 season, Coach King resigned to pursue opportunities and to watch his son play Junior A hockey in New England. After a four year hiatus, he starts his second tenure at the helm for the bruins.

Teaching the whole athlete and building a program based on fundamentals, sportsmanship, and hard work are the keys to the Lady Bruins' and Bruins' success. Along with Coach Seigenthaler and Coach King, the camping staff will include other Brentwood coaches and actual Bruin and Lady Bruin Varsity players.

**Medical Treatment Authorization & Liability Release**
