STUDENT ORGANIZATIONS

1 The principals may encourage students to broaden their knowledge and citizenship by permitting
2 the formation of school sponsored clubs or other groups organized to promote or pursue
3 specialized activities outside the classroom, provided membership is open to all interested and/or
4 eligible students, approval of the building principal is obtained, and a member of the faculty,
5 approved by the principal, attends the meeting or activity as an official sponsor and advisor.

8 Clubs which do not qualify as school sponsored clubs are considered to be non-school clubs and
9 normally beyond the jurisdiction of school authorities. Any club or organization not directly under
10 control of school authorities shall be deemed to be a non-school club. The formation of such clubs
11 shall be initiated by students. A student who wishes to organize a non-school club must obtain
12 prior written consent from the school principal and recruit a teacher to serve as a monitor of the
13 group's activity. The student organizer is, further, responsible for annually obtaining the written
14 consent of the parent(s)/guardian(s) of all students who wish to participate in the student-led
15 organization. Non-school clubs may not conduct their activities on campus during the instructional
16 day.
