

Williamson County School Health Partnership

Your child's school is participating in the Williamson County School Health Partnership and with your permission; school nursing staff can now provide the following services:

- ✓ Well child check-ups
- ✓ Immunizations (first month of school only)
- ✓ Screenings for blood pressure, weight, height, BMI (Body Mass Index)
- ✓ Case management of certain conditions, such as diabetes, asthma, etc.
- ✓ Health education
- ✓ Strep testing (some physicians will not accept results of another provider)

Services will be provided by current school nurses according to public health nursing protocol, signed by the Mid-Cumberland Regional (public health) Physician. Parents will be encouraged to come to the school during the provision of any services. If the parent cannot come to the school, written parental permission to perform the services will be required.

Services provided in your school previously, will continue to be provided free of charge.

Expanded services provided as a part of the Williamson County School Health Partnership will be billed to the patient's insurance, **if applicable**. Services not covered by insurance will be billed to the parent according to the family's income, **if applicable**. There will be **no** charge for over the counter medications provided by the health department.

A nurse, in a confidential setting, will provide all services and under no circumstances will school personnel, with the exception of the nurse, have access to your child's medical information.
