Parking Permits are \$10. Students who drive vehicles to school, park at their own risk and must understand that the school or Board of Education cannot be held responsible for the vehicle. Students are reminded that driving to school is a **privilege** not a right. The following rules apply to the parking lot and student driving:

- All students must register their cars. Students must complete a parking permit application and pay the appropriate parking fee. Replacement permits will be issued at an additional charge.
- Sale or transfer of permits between students or to any other car is prohibited.
- Cars may be parked only in the designated student parking lots.
- Parking lot speed limit of 10 mph is strictly enforced.
- **Students are not allowed to go to their cars during school hours.**
- Students who leave campus without the school's permission will be subject to the loss of parking privileges, whether driving a vehicle or not.
- Parking violations, such as parking in faculty spaces, parking in a prohibited area, speeding, or going the wrong way on a one-way street, will result in the loss of the parking permit.
- Vehicles without permits that are parked in the student or faculty spaces will be towed at owners' expense.
- Upon arrival to school, students are to exit their vehicles immediately and move into the building. Students are not to loiter in cars or the parking lot before or after school.
- Neither the school nor any staff member will be responsible for any damages to car locks or batteries if a request for help is made by the student or parents.
- Students who drive to school and park on school property agree to the search of their vehicles by administrators who have "reasonable suspicion" that the student's car contains drugs, alcohol, weapons, or other items not permissible at school.
- Students providing their own transportation are expected to be on time. Habitual tardiness will result in loss of driving privileges.
- Protect your property. **LOCK YOUR VEHICLE.**
