Suggested Sequence:

9th grade: 5504- Health Science Education

10th grade: 5506- Medical Therapeutics

11th grade: 5511- Diagnostic Medicine

12th grade: 5501- Clinical Internship

5504: Health Science

Credit: 1

The course will include basic health care information on services/products related to the health of people. Subject matter will include career choices, skill development, and application of health concepts relative to becoming a health care professional.

5506: Medical Therapeutics

Credit: 1

The student will evaluate the ways therapeutic medicine is used to focus on direct patient care. Topics could include pharmacology, basic nursing skills, medicine, dentistry, and a multitude of other aspects of allied health career areas.

5511: Diagnostic Medicine

Credit: 1

The student will learn the ways diagnostic medicine creates a picture of an individual's health at a single point in time. Diagnostic services may include dental services, radiologic imaging, laboratory skills, and other forms of diagnostic medicine.

5501: Clinical Internship

Credit: 1

The student will apply skills for successful entrance into postsecondary education and a career in health care. The skills include verbal and non verbal communication, assessments, patient/client care, and team membership. In a scenario, students will be given a situation that is within their scope of training for clinical internship. They will utilize the health care facilities' resources to problem solve and determine the course of care for a specific patient.
