

Dress Code:

Students should use such taste in the selection and wearing of their clothes, make-up, and hair styles and maintain such neatness, cleanliness, and self-respect that the school is a desirable place in which to promote learning and character development.

THE BASIC STANDARD:

- No tank tops, crop tops, or fish-net/see-through material
- No unacceptably short shorts or skirts (fingertip length)
- All pants or trousers must stay at the waist
- Underwear must not be visible.
- Shoes should be appropriate for school (No high heels or excessively high platform shoes.) Tennis shoes should be worn on PE days.
- Hair should be kept to appropriate colors and style so not to disrupt classroom instruction (example: blue, pink, purple, etc.)

Any apparel or dress that advertises or promotes products or activities prohibited by law or the Board of Education is prohibited. This includes profanity, illustrations, or suggestive language, etc.
