At Westwood Elementary, we have three "community expectations" to help students and teachers achieve the kind of school climate that Westwood Elementary Students need and deserve:

**WES students are RESPONSIBLE**  
**WES students are READY**

Students begin the school year by defining these expectations and describing what RESPECTFUL, RESPONSIBLE, and READY students look like, sound like, and act like. Classrooms will agree on appropriate behaviors and will develop a set of appropriate consequences for behaviors that do not meet expectations.
