Integrated Science

- **Emphasis will be placed on the following themes:**
 - › Structure, composition and behavior of matter
 - › Atmospheric concentration and processes
 - › Cells and cellular processes
 - › Human body systems
 - › Genetics, heredity and adaptations
- **Students will participate in many hands-on laboratory activities in order to build the following skills:**
 - › Data analysis
 - › Providing evidential support of scientific claims
 - › Communicate findings to a specific audience.

7th Grade World History

- ① 7th grade World History classes will examine and analyze the following:
 - › Legacy of the Roman Empire
 - › Middle Ages including the Middle East, Africa, China, Japan and Europe
 - › Western civilization in Europe during the Renaissance and Reformation
 - › Growth of economic interactions among civilizations
 - › Meso-American and Andean civilizations, as well as the European explorations and colonizations

Language Arts

- This course covers the state of Tennessee 7th grade ELA standards.
- Students follow the Williamson county Scope and Sequence for 7th Grade ELA
- Based on performance in 7th Grade ELA, as well as TNReady/TCAP scores, students will be placed in standard or advanced Language Arts in 8th Grade.

Language Arts Curriculum

- ◎ Students will learn the 8th grade Language Arts standards. An emphasis will be placed on the following themes:
 - > Analytical reading and thinking skills
 - Informational Texts
 - Literature - Students study two novels per year
 - > Writing – Utilizing textual evidence to support ideas
 - Informational
 - Narrative
 - Argumentative
 - > Research Projects (incorporated in each nine weeks)
 - > Grammar – Embed prior/new concepts in writing
 - > Latin and Greek vocabulary study

Mathematics Classes

● 7th Grade Math

- › This course covers the state of Tennessee 7th grade math standards.
- › Students that complete this course will enter Algebraic Concepts in 8th grade.
- › Students will take the TNReady test for 7th grade math.

● Prerequisites:

- › Mastery of 6th grade math standards as evidenced by TNReady scores and teacher recommendation.

Mathematics Classes

● 7th Grade Pre-Algebra

- › This course covers the state of Tennessee 8th grade math standards.
- › Students will take the TNReady test for 8th grade math.
- › Students that successfully complete this course, and meet all prerequisites, will enter Honors Algebra I in 8th grade.

● Prerequisites:

- › Students must complete 6th grade math (Level 2) with an 85% yearly average or above
- › Students must score an 85% or above on the Pre-Algebra placement test.
- › 6th grade math teacher recommendation

Mathematics Classes

● 7th Grade Honors Algebra I

- › This course covers the state of Tennessee Algebra I standards at the high school level.
- › Students are required to take the Algebra I TNReady EOC.

● Prerequisites:

- › Students must complete 6th grade math (Level 3) with an 88% final average or above.
- › Students must score an 85% or above on the Algebra I Readiness placement test.
- › 6th grade math teacher recommendation

PLC & THRIVE

- ◎ Teachers work in academic teams weekly to:
 - › Identify the essential learning goals
 - › Design instruction aligned to the learning goals
 - › Create formative and summative assessments
 - › Analyze student assessment data
 - › Design targeted intervention and enrichment for students based on performance data.
- ◎ **THRIVE is a 45 minute class designed to empower students to take ownership of their learning.**

THRIVE

- ◎ Each week academic teams review student performance data to create THRIVE sessions to support students at all levels.
- ◎ THRIVE sessions are designed each week to:
 - › Enrichment and extension activities
 - › Targeted homework help and extra practice
 - › Reteaching of important concepts/essential learning
 - › Quiz and test preparation and review sessions
 - › Chromebook labs, missing work sessions, silent work sessions, physical activity

2019-2020 Immunization Form

- All 7th grade students are required BY STATE LAW to submit a current immunization form prior to the first day of the 2019-2020 school year. Your doctor has the current form and it can be found at the Williamson County Health Department.
- Your child will not be able to attend 7th grade classes until this form is turned in to the BMS Front Office.
- The form must include the following:
 - › Two doses of the Chicken Pox Vaccine (Varicella) OR the date of the disease
 - › One dose of Tdap (Tetanus/Diphtheria w/accelerated Pertussis) Vaccine or proof of the TD booster given less than 5 years before 7th grade entry.

2019-2020 Immunization Form

- It must be on the CURRENT State of Tennessee form, which your doctor will provide.
- It must show the physicians signature and address of the office.
- The square in the lower left corner corresponding to “complete 7th grade or higher” should be checked.
- This form can be emailed (kathya@wcs.edu), faxed (615-472-4263), or dropped off to Kathy Anderson in the BMS front office.
- You can turn in your NEW immunization form to the front office beginning NOW!!

Spanish I (7A)

- Spanish I (7A/8B) is designed for students to take Spanish I Honors over two years.
- Spanish I (7A) will cover the 1st semester of Spanish I Scope and Sequence in 7th grade and the 2nd semester Scope and Sequence in 8th grade.
- Students who complete Spanish I (7A) must enroll in Spanish I (8B) in 8th grade in order to receive the HS credit.
- Students enter the 9th grade fully prepared for Spanish II Honors.
