

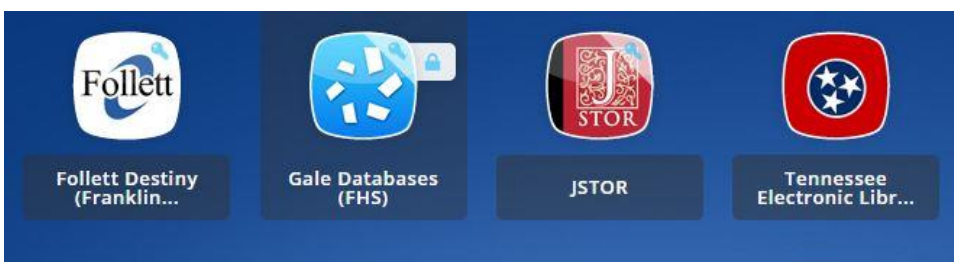
Library Media Specialists are Certified Teachers who
