WHAT IS ENCORE?

Encore is a summer enrichment camp offered to students who have completed grades K-5 by the end of this school year. It is designed to provide students with exploratory learning experiences based on their personal interests. Students will have opportunities to participate in fun and creative classes while building friendships.

WHAT YOUR CHILD WILL ENJOY:

*VARIETY OF INTERESTS: Students will attend 5 classes per day

*TIME TO EXPLORE: Each class is 55 minutes long

*SMALL CLASS SIZES: Classes will have about 12 students

CAMP DATES

JULY 10-14

DAILY CAMP TIMES:

*ENCORE hours for campers are 8:30-2:50 daily

*Arrival is between 8:30-8:40 (doors open at 8:30)

*Dismissal begins at 2:50.

*All students must be picked up in the back car line

OTHER SCHEDULING INFORMATION:

*On each day of camp, parents will drop kids off as normal in the back line. Students will come inside and get their name tag with classes on it.

LUNCH

- Students should pack a sack lunch each day.
- PLEASE LABEL YOUR CHILD'S LUNCH WITH THEIR FIRST & LAST NAME.
- Students with allergies will have a marked section for safety.

DISMISSAL

- Dismissal begins at 2:50. All students must be picked up by 3:05.
- All car lanes will be open during dismissal. Pull into any car lane, go as far as you can, then put your vehicle in park and TURN OFF THE ENGINE.
- Please have your car tag If picking up students from another family please coordinate with their parents to have their car tag on hand too.
- **CAR TAG PICKUP WILL BE IN THE FRONT OFFICE THE WEEK BEFORE CAMP**
- A teacher will come collect your car tag and give it to your child. At this point please do not switch lanes as this messes with our dismissal flow. Your child will bring the car tag back to you.
- When all engines are off, students will be dismissed to walk to their car. We will most likely have 2 rounds daily and will work to make dismissal as quick as possible while ensuring safety of all campers.
- Please keep your engine turned off until you see cars moving. This is for student safety. Cars are big and they are small :)

WHAT TO WEAR

- If you registered for a physical activity course, students should plan on wearing tennis shoes to camp each day. Do not bring extra shoes—wear them all day.
- If you registered for an art class, students may bring in an art shirt to leave at school for the week. Please write your child's first and last name on the tag/shirt.

HEALTH AND MEDICAL CARE

July is hot! Bring labeled water bottles to carry with you.

We will have a nurse on staff for the week. If your child needs something specific please plan to come by the front office to discuss with her. If you indicate a special medical plan on your registration we will be reaching out to you.
