1	Minor Disruptive Classroom Behavior	1st Offense: Verbal warning (at teacher discretion) 2nd Offense: Issue strike(s) 3rd Offense: Issue strike(s) and parent contact ***Teacher must contact parent if issuing three or more strikes to an individual student within a two-week period.
1	Insubordination/Not following directions	
1	Unprepared for class (Chromebook, materials, assignments, forms, etc.)	
1	Minor disrespect of students or staff (talking back, mocking, etc.)	
1	Tardy to class	
2	Inappropriate use of technology (playing games during class, accessing social media, misuse of email/Google drive, etc.)	
3	Lunchroom behavior (throwing items, etc.)	
3	Horseplay	
5	Profanity (not directed at an adult) ***Students using Profanity will be assigned an automatic detention***

Profanity towards students or staff	<p>1st Offense: Administrator contacts parent and issues consequence per WCS Policy</p> <p>Consequences may include:</p> <p>Saturday School (2-hour detention)</p> <p>In-School Suspension (ISS)</p> <p>Out-of-School Suspension (OSS)</p> <p>Alternative Learning Center (ALC) Placement</p> <p>*Certain inappropriate contact may also be documented by the SRO</p>
Inappropriate contact or physical aggression (pushing, shoving, tripping, slapping, etc.)*	
Skipping class or not being in an assigned location	
Minor vandalism of school property (writing on desks, bathroom stalls, making a mess in the restroom, etc.)	
Violations of the academic honor code (i.e. cheating on assignments or tests, plagiarism etc.)	
Violation of <i>Acceptable Use Agreement</i> (AUG) for technology

Description of Behavior	Range of Consequences (Discretion of WMS Administration)
Bringing to school or being in unauthorized possession of a firearm or any dangerous weapon on school property	<p style="text-align: center;">1st Offense: Administrator contacts parent, issues out-of-school suspension, and contacts SRO</p> <p style="text-align: center;">For more information, refer to Williamson County School Board policy 6.309.</p>
Possession of drugs or alcohol, including any controlled substance, controlled substance analogue, or legend drug on school grounds or at a school-sponsored event	
Aggravated assault	
Assault that results in bodily injury upon any teacher, principal, administrator, any other employee of the school, or school resource officer
