Tammy McAllister went over the treasurer's report. Our balance in the account is \$34,619.76. Hawk Walk brought in \$20,128.31- cost for prizes and expenses was \$2,269.57. Enrichment activities expenses were approx. \$2,100. Dispersed this year: Teacher Materials - \$4,000, Biz Town - \$2,000, Chorus - \$1,000. Upcoming budgeted expenses will be 5th grade celebration, Teacher Appreciation and Auction. The City of Fairview donated \$1,000 to the PTO. Amber Moultrie made a motion the minutes be approved as written. Motion was seconded and passed.

Old Business:

Hawk Walk Recap: We raised enough money to slime Mr. Oakley! All prizes have been distributed except for ice cream coupons and those will be done once we get the remaining coupons donated from Sonic.
