Registration Materials:

Fairview High School counselors will begin handing out registration materials and answering questions for all 8th grade students on January 15th, 2019.

*** Copy of signed lease agreement, real estate sales contract, settlement statement, deed or similar proof of residency**

Parents of students with an Individual Education Plan will complete the registration process through bridging meetings and **do not** sign up with the link below. Your file holder will contact you with a meeting time.
