1 The Board may engage the services of qualified professional consultants and encourages the use of
2 consultants as a means of providing specialized services not available to staff.

3 The Superintendent of Schools shall:

- 4 1. Determine the specific objectives to be accomplished by the consultant;
- 5 2. Define the need and state specific tasks to be performed;
- 6 3. Establish criteria for the selection of consultants;
- 7 4. Conduct a comparative cost analysis of consultant services;
- 8 5. Contract with consultant; and
- 9 6. In the event any one consultant cost singularly exceeds, ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00),
10 Board approval shall be received prior to contracting with the consultant.

11 The Superintendent of Schools will establish procedures necessary to develop an efficient working
12 relationship between the consultant and the Board and/or staff members.
