GIFTS AND BEQUESTS

1 The Board may receive donations of money, property, or securities from any source for the benefit
2 of the schools which shall be disbursed, in good faith, in accordance with the conditions of such
3 gifts, with the Board to be vested with title to any gift.
4

5 Gifts which may serve to enhance and extend the work of the schools may be received by the
6 district. It shall be the general policy of the district to direct those who desire to make contributions
7 to consider equipment or services that are not likely to be acquired from public fund expenditures.
8 The Board shall be vested with the title to any gift.

- 11 1. Equipment contributed to the schools becomes the property of the district and is subject to
12 the same controls and regulations that govern the use of other school-owned property.

 - 14 2. Contributions of equipment or services that may involve major costs for installation or
15 maintenance, or initial or continuing financial commitments from school funds shall be
16 presented by the Superintendent of Schools office for Board consideration and approval
17 prior to their implementation.
18
 - 19 3. Individuals or organizations desiring to contribute supplies or equipment will counsel with
20 school officials regarding the acceptability of such contributions in advance of the
21 solicitation of funds or the making of budgetary appropriations.
