BUSINESS AND LABOR ORGANIZATIONS

1 Neither the Williamson County Public Schools nor school-centered groups shall enter into
2 partnership with private business for the sole purpose of making profit, but these schools, at their
3 election, may enter into a working relationship with private business provided the service or product
4 involved is a desirable part of the school operation. However, the profit accruing to the school in
5 the course of such business must be secondary to the prime purpose of providing only these
6 products or services desirable in the school life of the child. Specific examples of permissible sales
7 of products of services purchased from selected suppliers would be the following:
