SAFETY

1 The principals, with assistance from the central staff, shall assume leadership in developing
2 procedures for keeping school facilities safe and free from hazards to the life and safety of children
3 and teachers.
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5 The necessary precautions shall be taken to minimize the possibilities of fire, explosion, and
6 comparable dangerous incidents from occurring.
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9 Each principal is responsible for seeing that the practice of safety is a part of the school and that it
10 is appropriately geared to students at different grade levels. All staff members shall be periodically
11 reminded of the necessity of their responsibility for promptly reporting both current and potential
12 hazards to their supervisors. Supervisors are expected to promptly and effectively follow up on
13 these reports.
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15 The principal shall secure assistance from law enforcement officials when he or she deems it
16 necessary in order to maintain order or security during the school day or during extracurricular
17 activities at school.
