ENERGY MANAGEMENT AND CONSERVATION

1 It is the policy of Williamson County Schools to ensure that every effort is made to conserve energy
2 and natural resources while exercising sound financial management. To minimize the impact
3 increased energy costs have on the district's operating budget, energy management efforts are to
4 be implemented district-wide without infringement upon the educational mission of Williamson
5 County Schools. Maintenance of the learning environment shall always take precedence over
6 energy conservation measures.

9 The judicious use of the various energy systems of each facility will be the joint responsibility of the
10 Principal and the Maintenance Director to ensure that an efficient energy posture is maintained on
11 a daily basis. It shall be the responsibility of all employees and students to actively participate in
12 conservation efforts.

14 Accurate records of energy consumption and the cost of energy will be maintained by the district's
15 Energy Manager. The Principal will provide leadership and support for energy management and
16 conservation. All operations of facilities will be governed by established administrative rules and
17 guidelines designed to implement the Board's intent to manage and conserve energy resources.

19 Williamson County Schools will comply with the following:
20

- 21 1. The most recent adoption of ASHRAE Standard 90.1 (the minimum standard for energy
22 efficiency);
- 23 2. The most recent version of ASHRAE Standard 62.1 (the minimum standard for indoor air
24 quality); and
- 25 3. The most recent version of ASHRAE Standard 55 (the minimum standard for human
26 comfort).
