LONG-RANGE PLANNING

1 In its planning, the Board and Superintendent of Schools shall enlist the aid of parents, teachers,
2 and community groups, as needed.

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4 Long-range planning shall involve:

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6 1. The Physical Plants

- 7 a. Number and size of elementary and high school buildings at various times in the future.
8 b. Replacement of obsolete equipment.
9 c. Repair program for painting, plumbing, electrical work, roofing, and grounds
10 improvement.
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13 2. Educational Programming

- 14 a. Maintenance of good public relations.
15 b. Continual re-examination and evaluation of school procedures.
16 c. Upgrading of the teaching staff by careful selection and provisions for in-service
17 education.
18 d. Continual re-examination of the curriculum and the adoption of the necessary new
19 materials for its implementation.
20 e. Continual re-examination of such areas as testing, guidance, and counseling, etc.
21 f. Establishment of such educational programs and services as may be necessary to
22 satisfy changing community needs.
23 g. Continual re-examination of special services to pupils, such as visual education,
24 special education, school health services, psychological services, lunchroom
25 services, and pupil recreation.
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
