LONG-RANGE PLANNING INVOLVEMENT

1 To interpret the needs of the educational program in terms of facility requirements, the
2 Superintendent of Schools will recommend procedures whereby Board members, professional and
3 classified personnel, students, consultants, and the general public may be involved appropriately in
4 the planning process.

7 Throughout the planning and development of educational facilities, provision(s) will be made to
8 provide a systematic and continual process, involving all educational departments and professional
9 staff. Decisions regarding facilities will be made primarily on the basis of providing desirable
10 educational programming solutions. Teachers, Principals and staff members will be involved in
11 developing and updating educational specifications.
12

13 The Board recognizes the complexities of providing physical facilities in a rapidly growing county.
14 This responsibility is complicated by the demands for change made by a dynamic educational
15 program.

18 Consultants and other appropriate resource personnel from the State Department of Education,
19 colleges, universities, and consultants may be used to augment school system personnel when
20 needed and authorized by the Superintendent of Schools.
