EDUCATIONAL SPECIFICATIONS

1 To insure that facilities being planned are designed to best implement the educational program, the  
2 Superintendent of Schools will provide for the establishment of educational specifications to apply  
3 when planning and building school facilities.  
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5 These educational specifications will be developed in a manner designed to provide involvement of  
6 teachers, administrators, and other appropriate persons.  
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9 The educational specifications may include the following information:

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11 1. Facilities list outlining the grade structure of the facility, design capacity and list quantity and  
12 size of all proposed education spaces.  
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- 14 2. The description of the curriculum and programs to be offered (science, math, computers,  
15 technology, etc.)  
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- 17 3. Size and number of spaces required to support these populations engaged in those  
18 activities.  
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- 20 4. The relationships among areas of site and plant (band room and library, playing fields and  
21 locker rooms, front office and general school control, etc.)  
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- 23 5. Special site considerations of aesthetics, (traffic patterns, cooperative community use, etc.)  
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- 25 6. The descriptions, quantity and sizes of furniture and equipment to be included in the  
26 construction contract as well as descriptions of furniture not to be excluded from  
27 construction contract.  
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- 29 7. Any other kind of information that will give guidance to the architect in designing a building  
30 which will facilitate the implementation of the educational program.  
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
