SUMMER SCHOOL

ELEMENTARY AND MIDDLE SCHOOL

Williamson County Schools may sponsor a summer school for elementary and middle school students to strengthen and reinforce basic skills in any academic area.

Summer school may be offered and will operate within the following parameters:

1. Based on teacher recommendations and student need principals will identify students to attend summer school.
2. Principals may require students who do not meet grade level expectations to attend remediation after school or in summer school as a condition for promotion. The final decision for promotion/retention rests with school personnel.
3. Summer school is limited to students enrolled in the Williamson County Schools.
4. Tuition may be charged to offset the cost of this program.

HIGH SCHOOL

Williamson County Schools may sponsor a summer school for high school students. A high school summer program shall meet the criteria below. Students may also enroll in E-courses in lieu of summer school.

1. Courses offered will be for remediation, and may include make-up courses for students who have failed any courses during the regular school year.
2. Tuition shall be charged to offset all costs of the summer programs.
3. Maximum high school credits which may be earned during the summer school shall be two.
4. An annual Summer School Report will be submitted to the Board in September.
