HOMEBOUND INSTRUCTION

1 Students who are unable to attend school due to physical, emotional, health impairment, or other  
2 conditions shall be offered homebound instruction.

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4 Homebound instruction shall be offered if it is determined that the student will miss more than ten  
5 (10) consecutive school days.  
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7 Homebound instruction is defined as a minimum of three (3) hours per week of direct teaching.  
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10 It is the responsibility of the parent to provide documentation from the physician indicating that the  
11 student is unable to attend school. Forms which permit such documentation shall be provided by  
12 the Student Support Services Department or by the school nurse.  
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14 It is the responsibility of the classroom teacher to provide assignments to the homebound teacher  
15 during the time the student is enrolled in the homebound program.  
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17 The homebound teacher shall be the liaison between the student and the classroom teacher.
