DRUG EDUCATION

1 It is the responsibility of the Williamson County Schools to safeguard the health, character,
2 citizenship and personality development of students in the schools. Since the use of alcohol,
3 tobacco, inhalants and other drugs* constitutes a hazard to the positive development of students,
4 with the leadership of the instructional supervisors, the schools shall:
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- 6 1. Provide K-12 drug prevention curricula and programs.
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- 8 2. Establish and maintain operational procedures to effectively address the issue of
9 substance abuse among students, including the utilization of the Student
10 Assistance Program countywide.
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- 12 3. Establish and maintain appropriate procedures for adhering to the legal
13 requirements related to alcohol, tobacco, inhalants, and other drugs*.
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- 15 4. Cooperate with local, state and federal agencies that are involved in the health of
16 students related to the use of alcohol, tobacco, inhalants and other drugs*.
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- 18 5. Maintain a continuing professional development program for school personnel to
19 aid them in addressing concerns through a behavior observation and referral
20 process or through disciplinary measures if warranted.
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30 **Drug** means any narcotic or stimulant drug, prescription drug, or any other controlled substance
