DRIVER EDUCATION

1 The Board believes that the driver education course contributes to greater highway safety. The
2 Board therefore authorizes the establishment of such a program for all eligible students of the
3 county schools. It will be an elective course offered outside the regular school day and in summer
4 school with all costs being supported by tuition fees. One half (1/2) credit is given for successful
5 completion of the course (30 hours classroom instruction and 6 hours hands-on-behind-the-wheel
6 instruction) according to approved State guidelines. The driver education course shall include
7 defensive driving.
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10 This course will be entered on the high school transcript as Credit or No Credit with no grade point
11 (GPA) value.
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13 All driver education instructors must meet the following criteria: (1) hold current Tennessee teacher
14 certification endorsement for driver education; (2) hold a valid current Tennessee driver's license;
15 (3) be approved for employment by the Board of Education; and (4) have a safe driving record: (a)
16 forever free from any DUI or DWI offenses and (b) less than three moving violations within the most
17 recent three years, according to Tennessee Motor Vehicle Department records.
