SCHOOL LIBRARY MEDIA CENTERS

- 1 The Board recognizes that a quality library media program provides a foundation for lifelong
- 2 learning by combining learning / teaching strategies and activities with information access skills,
- 3 ensuring that all students can interact effectively with information and construct meaningful
- 4 knowledge. The school library media program is an integral part of the educational program at
- 5 every grade level and in all subject areas and reinforces and enriches the curriculum.
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- 8 The school system will provide and maintain adequate school library media centers to support the
- 9 educational program.
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- 11 The school library media center should not be used as a study hall or as classroom space, if other
- 12 alternatives are available.
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- 14 The library media specialists shall work closely with the principal in a supportive manner. The
- 15 principal has the specific responsibility of interpreting to his staff in a positive manner the role of the
- 16 library media personnel, library media function and its current and potential resources in the
- 17 educational program of that school.
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- 20 All educational media, including print, non-print, and equipment, shall be catalogued, inventoried,
- 21 and disseminated in a defined system to support the educational program.
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- 23 Maximum student and faculty use are to be emphasized and facilitated.
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- 25 The school district will provide and maintain media to support the educational program within the
- 26 funds available.
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
