EXCHANGE TEACHING

1 The Board recognizes the value of personnel exchange programs and thus authorizes such
2 exchanges. Personnel exchanges must be recommended by the Superintendent of Schools and
3 be approved at a regular meeting of the Board.
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5 Exchange teaching both inside and outside the United States shall be encouraged and accepted
6 for professional development credit.
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8 Normally, the Board shall grant a leave of absence for not more than one school year to tenured
9 teachers for purposes of accepting an appointment to an exchange teaching assignment or
10 appointment to an overseas teaching assignment or to a "one-way domestic" teaching assignment.
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12 The applicant shall submit and have approved in advance by the Superintendent of Schools, a plan
13 for such leave. Requests for exchange employment shall be made at least 90 days prior to the
14 beginning of the school year for which the leave is requested. The teacher shall show the personal
15 benefit as well as the benefit to the district, and shall file with the Superintendent of Schools, a
16 report upon return from such a leave.
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19 A teacher returning from a one year leave shall be assigned to his former position, and shall be
20 accorded the same consideration with respect to salary placement as though he had been actively
21 engaged in teaching in the district during the year he was on leave.
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
