COMPLAINTS AND GRIEVANCES

1 In the event a student, or group of students, would like to appeal a non-disciplinary decision made
2 by the administration of the school, the student(s) may present the item in question to the
3 Superintendent of Schools, and the decision of the Superintendent of Schools may be appealed to
4 the School Board.

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6 The Williamson County Board of Education has adopted the following grievance procedure for
7 handling such student complaints:
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- 10 1. The grievance must be filed with the person against whom the complaint is
11 made, with a copy to the Principal and a copy to the Superintendent of
12 Schools.
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 - 14 2. All parties involved in the complaint will be notified of a hearing date within
15 30 days of the Superintendent of Schools' receipt of the grievance.
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 - 17 3. The persons involved will appear before a six-member committee appointed
18 by the Superintendent of Schools. The school involved will be excluded
19 from the hearing.
