WILLIAMSON COUNTY COLLEGE NIGHT

1 Information about post-secondary educational opportunities should be made available to all high
2 school students with special emphasis on juniors and seniors. Printed booklets, catalogs,
3 pamphlets and computer-based data should be made available.
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5 All district high schools are encouraged to work together to share information and to have joint
6 informational programs. A major activity should be an annual COLLEGE NIGHT. This joint program
7 should comply with the following guidelines:
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- 10 1. Be planned and promoted jointly by all high schools;
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 - 12 2. Include information on each high school's financial aid workshop(s), including dates;
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 - 14 3. Include post-secondary education or training agencies/institutions (e.g., colleges,
15 universities, special vocational/technical schools, military academies);
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 - 17 4. Exclude any financial aid institution or any for-profit agency (e.g., banks, insurance
18 companies, placement services) that involves the purchase of a plan, policy, or service
19 and/or requires a fee to be paid in order to participate in the financial or placement service;
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 - 21 5. Exclude school or school-related organizations seeking to recruit members or solicit funds
22 during the program.
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25 The College Night program seeks to maximize the quantity and quality of participation by students,
26 parents, and post-secondary education representatives. To accomplish this purpose, budgetary
27 support for the promotional and operating costs of College Night is a goal of this Board.
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
