SCHOOL ADMISSIONS

1 A complete medical examination of every child entering school for the first time is required. No
2 child shall be admitted to school without proof of immunization. However, no child shall be denied
3 admission to any school if such child has not been immunized due to medical reasons if such child
4 has a written statement from his doctor excusing him from such immunization if such immunization
5 would be in any manner harmful to the child involved.
6

7 Proof of immunization shall be established by a certificate of immunization listing all immunizations
8 which a child has received. All certificates of immunization shall be on forms furnished by the
9 Department of Health and Environment and signed by a physician or health care provider
10 administering immunizations.
11

12 All foreign born children entering a Williamson County School for the first time, are required to
13 present evidence of freedom from infectious tuberculosis. The evidence should include a report of
14 a negative tuberculin skin test done in the United States, or if the skin test is positive, a chest x-ray
15 or other necessary examinations to certify absence of clinical tuberculosis.
