STUDENT AID PROGRAMS

1 If satisfactory proof is presented that any child is unable to attend school as required because he  
2 is not able to procure books and workbooks, said books shall be purchased out of the public  
3 school fund and lent or given to the child during the term such books are needed. The care and  
4 return of such books shall be in accord with other materials loaned by the system to the student.

6  
7 If any child, who is required to attend school, is unable to do so due to lack of clothing or food,  
8 such case shall be reported to the local welfare agency; provided further, that any worthy case not  
9 receiving immediate relief shall be reported to the county official having charge of such works for  
10 investigation and relief.  
11

12 No student shall be required to pay a fee to the school for any purpose, except as authorized by  
13 the Board, and provided further that no fees or tuition shall be required of any student as a  
14 condition to attending the school, or using its equipment while receiving educational training.
