

Out-of- Transportation Zone for College, Career & Technical Education Program Application

Any student interested in participating in a College, Career & Technical Education (CTE) Program of Study that is not available at his/her zoned school may request an Out-of-Transportation Zone approval to attend another WCS high school that offers the desired program. The CTE programs listed below, may have limited seat availability at the schools identified with the program of study. *Completion of the application process does not guarantee admittance into the program of study.* A WCS selection committee will notify all applicants when selections are determined.

Once a student is approved for a program not at his/her school they will be required to complete an official Out of Transportation Zone request form. ***All applications are due on or before April 12th.***
