



Williamson County Schools School Age Child Care

The Williamson County Schools School Age Child Care (SACC) program provides extended care programming at the county elementary schools. Below are some frequently asked questions by parents about the SACC program.

HOW DO I REGISTER?

- To register for the SACC program go to www.ezchildtrack.com/sacc/parent
- For new families, select “Click Here to Register” under “New Customers Open Account” and complete the registration process.
- For existing SACC families, please log into your parent portal to enroll.
- Pay the \$35 per child registration fee for the 2018/2019 school year. You can do this online with a credit card or e-check. There is not a fee to pay by e-check. Payments are not accepted at the site.
- Notify your child’s classroom teacher of your dismissal plan.
- Upon completion of the registration process you will receive a confirmation email, please save this email for your records.

WHEN DOES PROGRAMMING BEGIN?

- SACC will begin programming at 6:30 a.m. on Friday, August 10, 2018 for children in 1st-5th grade.
- The first day of school is a half-day, SACC will be available the afternoon of August 10 for those needing care. Children attending on this day will need to bring a sack lunch, an afternoon snack will be provided.
- **Kindergarten students can begin attending SACC on the first full day of kindergarten on Monday, August 20 at 6:30 a.m.**
- Students in the Williamson County Schools Pre-K classrooms are eligible to attend the SACC program. WCS pre-k students can begin attending on their first full day of Pre-K.

WHAT ARE THE RATES TO ATTEND SACC?

- SACC provides Full-time care and Drop-In care.

- Full-Time care is for families needing child care most days of the week. SACC provides full-time mornings, full-time afternoons, or full-time mornings and afternoons. If you sign up for full-time care, you pay a set fee each week. Sibling discounts are available. Full-time rates run from \$35-\$56 per child depending on the level of care needed.

- Students enrolled in full-time morning only care or full-time afternoon only care are eligible to attend SACC as a drop-in for the opposing time spot.
- Drop-in care is available for families of elementary age children needing care 1 or 2 days a week or on an occasional basis. With this level of care you are billed for days that the child/children attend SACC. Fees are \$16 for morning care, \$20 for afternoon care, and \$25 on half days of care.
- When school is out due to breaks, professional development, inclement weather, etc, weekly tuition rates will be pro-rated. Children signed up for full day programming will be billed accordingly.
- Full Day care is \$30 for non-field trips days and \$35 on field trips days. Advanced registration is required except on inclement weather days.
- Payment is due each week on Monday for the current week.
- Payments must be made online through the parent portal by e-check or credit card. Payments are no longer accepted at the site. Credit card payments incur at 3% processing fee and paying by e-check does not incur a fee.

WHEN ARE YOU OPEN?

- SACC provides year round programming Monday-Friday.
- We operate school year programming and summer day camp.
- During the school year SACC provides care from 6:30 a.m. until the start of school and from the release of school until 6 p.m.
- SACC is open most days that school is out and provides full day programming from 6:30 a.m.-6 p.m.
- On inclement weather days SACC operates from 7 a.m.-5 p.m. at designated locations.

HOW IS SACC DIFFERENT FROM OTHER EXTENDED CARE PROGRAMMING OFFERED?

- SACC is a Williamson School Board program that shares the focus and values of the school board.
- SACC provides homework club Monday-Thursday. This is included in your tuition costs.
- SACC provides enrichment programming focusing on enrolled students' areas of interest. Enrichment programming will focus on academics, athletics, and the arts. A nominal fee is charged for enrichment participation.
- Full day care is themed with corresponding enrichment programming.
