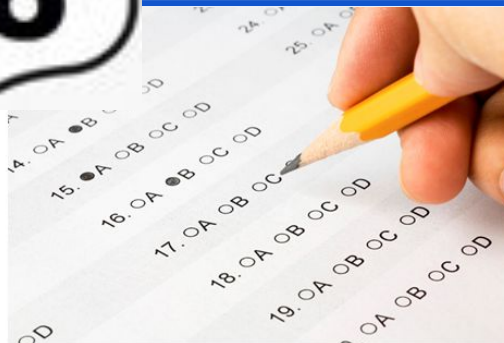

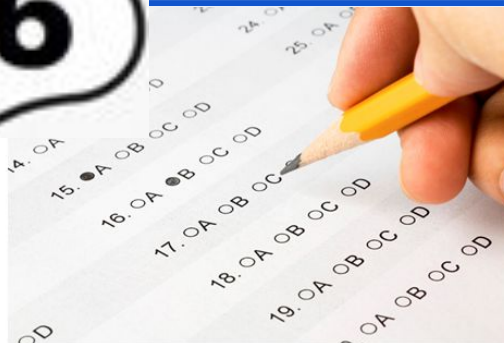

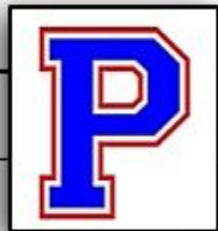

New Attendance/Truancy Procedures



- **Can excuse up to 8 with note from home**
- **After 8 total requires a note from doctor**
- **Receive a call after 3 unexcused**
- **Have a meeting after 5 unexcused**
- **Referred to Attendance Interventionist if unexcused continues**
- **Referred to juvenile court for truancy at 10 unexcused**

NEW POLICY: Senior Exemptions



Board Policy 4.7001

The provision of this policy set forth below shall be effective July 1, 2019.

Semester and final exams in a subject shall not be required for those high school **seniors** who have maintained an **A average** in that subject, **no unexcused absences**, and have **not been suspended during the semester**. Absences may be excused by the Principal pursuant to the standards of Board Policy 6.200, Attendance. Unless mandated by the State of Tennessee, seniors who meet the criteria for exemption are not required to take the final exam. Teachers will report the number of exempt students for each course to their Principal.

NEW POLICY: Senior Exemptions



1. NO Unexcused Absences
2. "A" average
3. NO Suspensions (ISS or ALC)
4. Seniors have 4 college visit days (Board Policy 4.302)
5. Parents write up to 8 notes to excuse an absence
6. After 8 notes; required doctor notes

New Attendance/Truancy Procedures



- Can excuse up to 8 with note from home
- After 8 total requires a note from doctor
- Receive a call after 3 unexcused
- Have a meeting after 5 unexcused
- Referred to Attendance Interventionist if unexcused continues
- Referred to juvenile court for truancy at 10 unexcused



Excused: illness, family illness, death in family, religious observance

Early Dismissal Procedures



- Bring note to Ms. Holder before 1st period
- Student will leave class at appropriate time with pass
- If student becomes ill, must go to clinic
- Student will remain in class until class change if morning note is not provided
- Goal is no classroom interruptions for early dismissals, particularly during 8th period



Senior Project--Mr. Josh Hollandsworth



- ⇒ Senior Project began at PHS in 1990's
- ⇒ WCS Graduation Requirement (paragraph 4.605)
- ⇒ Begins Spring of Junior Year--Introduced in English Class
- ⇒ Community Service/Internship - 40 hours BEGAN MARCH 15TH
- ⇒ 2 Recommendation Letters (PHS Staff and Community Member)
- ⇒ PPT Presentation in Fall of senior year (Nov. 21st)

Senior Project (con't)



1. Volunteering must be completed at a **NON-PROFIT** agency; students may not volunteer or intern for a family member
2. Must not receive any compensation for volunteering or internship - *no payment, gifts, t-shirts, or otherwise may be received by your student*
3. All hours must be completed between **March 15th(Spring Break) and the end of October**
4. Senior Project Board must approve a Non-Profit Agency if it is unknown by the board members
5. Students may volunteer up to 20 hours for PHS (that includes PTO and club sponsored fundraisers held on our property, *i.e. sports camps for elementary students*)
