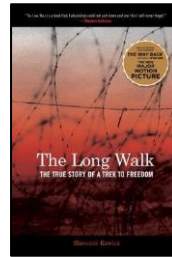


Book #1

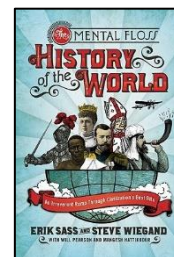
1. Read *The Long Walk* by Slavomir Rawicz.
