These nights are informational for parents regarding procedures and processes at Spring Station. Students may attend if they stay with parents during the evening. The documents mentioned below maybe submitted to the library on either of these nights.

Registration Documents Required at 6th Grade – Parents will need to bring the following to school before it begins:

- 1) Two of the following current bills (must be different ones): Water, electric or gas statements with address
- 2) Mortgage statement or current for the year Residency Affidavit. Residency Affidavit is used if you rent or live with another person who owns the home.

Class schedule pick up and locker assignment – Two business weeks in July from the 8th till the 19th parents will be able to pick up class schedules and receive locker assignments. The registration documents mentioned above may be presented at this time. There are two later hour dates during this time frame where we will be open from 3:30 till 7:00 pm, July 11th and 18th to try to accommodate working parents.

Any student that does not pick up his or her class schedule by July 31st will get a schedule the first day of school.

Fee and Supplies - We provide a fee and supply opportunity at Spring Station. You pay \$100 and that includes the service of us buying all the supplies except loose leaf paper and pencils. You will not have to go shopping for school supplies because we buy it for you! Teachers receive supplies during the school year as needed and students will receive from the teachers any items they might need for projects, balloons, chicken legs, M&Ms, you get the idea. This does not include special colored poster board a child might desire, computer paper or that “gotta have” notebook.
