

A Note from the Nurse...

- **Tetanus-diphtheria-pertussis booster (Tdap)**
- **Varicella**

Make those doctor appointments NOW! This is a state regulation to attend public schools in Tennessee. You may drop off your completed vaccine records in the front office over the summer. Students who are not compliant will not be able to attend school until this requirement has been met.
