## IT'S ALMOST TIME FOR SCHOOL...

### ARE YOU READY??

It's hard to believe that summer is almost over and school is about to begin. In order for your student to start off strong, please use the following checklist to make sure that they are ready to go!

- ⇒ All 6th graders need to have their Proofs of Residency turned in to the Front Office. You must show two utility bills that contain your name and address AND either your mortgage statement or lease agreement.
- ⇒ All 7th graders must have their updated immunization records turned in to the Front Office. If you are unable to get into your regular doctor to have these immunizations, the local health department has extended their regular hours.
- ⇒ All students can take care of their fees and purchase supplies through the Front Office. If you don't want to fight the crowds to purchase your student's school supplies, you are able to pay \$100 and all of their supplies and fees for the year will be covered! (The only things you will need to pick up for them are pencils and notebook paper.) If your student loves picking out their supplies, school fees are \$60 per student.
- ⇒ If you have not picked up your student's schedule, there is still time—just stop by the Front Office. Just keep in mind that you will not be able to go to your locker until school begins due to our floors being waxed at this time.
